International students enrolled in member The Consortium of Universities in Hyogo. (Primarily aimed at 3rd-year undergraduate and 1st-year graduate students, but all academic years are welcome to participate)

Δ Three Participation Requirements for the program Δ

Must be an international student wishing to work for a Japanese company or organization.
It is desirable to have Japanese language proficiency equivalent to JLPT N2-N1 level, with practical Japanese skills sufficient for writing reports and communicating at the internship placement.
