

What's すいどうすじ Suidosuji?

During the Taisho period, around 1926, a water pipeline was laid from Nishinomiya to Kobe, and a road was built over it. Over time, the area came to be known as "Suidosuji" (Waterworks Street). Today, eight shopping streets and four markets stretch narrowly from east to west, and the area is bustling with local residents.

Around this street is known as "deeply local" neighborhood in Kobe. Local people loves this street so much that they are working to revitalize it, helping small shops survive even as large shopping centers are becoming more popular.
